Or perhaps take a free guided tour by the Ski Friends, a volunteer group, two times daily starting at Whiskyjack Lodge.

## **Please Note:**

- Air Canada currently charges \$30 (each direction) for the first piece of checked luggage on domestic flights and \$50 for the second piece. (This would be for a ski/boot bag combo.) Please check with the airline prior to departure for the current extra luggage charges and baggage limits.
- Current flight taxes and surcharges are included but these may increase and the price of the trip will have to be adjusted accordingly.
- Generic advanced seating is completed at the time of booking by Air Canada Groups. Specific seat selection is not permitted and members may only change seat assignment at the airport prior to checkin.
- Trip prices are based on minimum number of travelers. Failure to meet this minimum will result in an increased cost per person.
