Sestriere, Italy - Via Lattea

Built by the owners of the Fiat car company in 1934 and owned by them for 70 years, Sestriere is one of the earliest and still one of the highest purpose-built ski stations. Sitting on a sunny plateau, snow cover is guaranteed thanks to both altitude and one of the world's most extensive snow making operations. Sestriere and Via Lattea ski resorts hosted the alpine events in the 2006 Turin Winter Olympics. Despite this honour Sestriere is an area best suited to intermediates on the piste. Some great advanced piste exists but it is not extensive. Challenging off-piste terrain is available for the adventurous and fresh snow can lay unsullied alongside piste runs for days. The Via Lattea gives Sestriere skiers access to nearly 400km of ski runs serviced by 70 lifts.

**** Hotel Principi di Piemonte

This beautiful ski in/ski out hotel on the edge of the village will be our host for the week. It is a short 15 minute walk into the town of Sestriere or you can take the complimentary hotel shuttle.

All rooms provide mini bar, TV, hair drier and bathrobes. The hotel features two restaurants serving local and gourmet cuisine managed by a Michelin star chef.

Our hotel package includes a rich buffet breakfast and multi course dinner daily as well as wine with dinner (one bottle per three people).

Insurance

It is strongly recommended that you have medical and cancellation/interruption for a ski trip outside Canada. This insurance includes coverage for medical evacuation by helicopter, standard practise in the Alps.

Cancellation insurance may only be purchased at time of trip deposit.

Costs are as follows (trip value of \$3300):

0 to 55 years: Medical = \$40.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$280.00.

56 to 59 years: Medical = \$40.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$280.00.

60 to 64 years: Medical = \$49.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$341.00.

65 to 69 years: Medical = \$63.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$419.00.

70 to 74 years: Medical = \$89.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$577.00.

75 to 79 years: Medical = \$239.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$726.00

80 to 85 years: Medical = \$415.00; All-inclusive Cancellation/Interruption, Medical & Baggage = \$942.00

Cancellation/Interruption Only

0 to 55 years: = \$222.00.

56 to 59 years: = \$222.00.

60 to 64 years: = \$251.00.

65 to 69 years: = \$270.00.

70 to 74 years: = \$312.00.

Please Note

- Lufthansa charges \$150 each way for a 2nd piece of check in luggage. This includes a ski/boot bag combo and is payable only at check-in. This past season the 2nd bag fee has been waived for a ski & boot bag combo by Lufthansa. There is no guarantee this will again be the case in 2019.
- Current flight taxes and surcharges are included but these may increase and the price of the trip will have to be adjusted accordingly.
- Generic advanced seating is completed at the time of booking by Air Canada Groups. Specific seat selection is not permitted and members may only change seat assignment at the airport prior to check-in.
